OLD BUSINESS

1) Approval of Minutes - Chief Copsey asked if all present had read the minutes for January 12, 2012. Paul Brunner made a motion that the minutes be approved. Bruce Buckingham seconded the motion. All present were in favor of approval of the Minutes.

2) South 11th Street and Rockaway Avenue

Citizen reports a parking issue at the corner of South 11th Street and Rockaway Avenue. When vehicles park at the corner, the drivers on Rockaway Avenue have a hard time seeing the northbound traffic on South 11th Street. Also, when vehicles park at the corner the vehicles block the mail boxes and the mail is not delivered.

The Traffic Committee discussed the citizen's concerns regarding the site distance and the request for painting the curb red. The Committee did not feel there were any safety issues. There has been no reported accidents in this area for the last five years. After discussion, Paul Brunner made a motion that the Traffic Committee does not recommend painting the curb red at the corner of South 11th Street and Rockaway

Avenue. Bruce Buckingham seconded the motion. All present were in favor of this motion.
