ATTENDANCE: Police Chief Jim Copsey, Interim Fire Chief Riki Heath, Community Development Director Bruce Buckingham, Public Works Director/City Engineer, Greg Ray, and Citizen Representative Paul Brunner.

Also present were Police Commander Tim Miller and Citizen Duke Sterling.

ABSENT: None.

Chief Copsey called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. Roll Call was then taken.

PUBLIC COMMUNICATIONS: Duke Sterling was there to support the 30 minute zones he is requesting at the corner of 5th Street and West Grand Avenue.

OLD BUSINESS

- 1) **Approval of Minutes** - Chief Copsey asked if all present had read the minutes for September 11, 2014. Paul Brunner made a motion that the minutes be approved. Interim Fire Chief Riki Heath seconded the motion. All present were in favor of approval of the Minutes.

NEW BUSINESS

1) South 5th Street and West Grand Avenue

Owners of a business on South 5th Street and West Grand Avenue are requesting a green 20 or 30 minute curb on South 5th Street (from West Grand Avenue to the driveway of the building located at 480 West Grand Avenue. We have a very busy Barber Shop on this corner with in and out traffic who wishes to have short-term parking here. Additionally we have problems with both, Enterprise Rent a Car and visitors to the Grover Beach Inn who frequently take the three parking spaces in this area. It makes it difficult for this business (or any of our commercial tenants) to find parking for their patrons.

Duke Sterling advised that he has talked with his tenants and they were all in favor of the green curbs being painted in this area with a specific time zone.

After discussion by the Traffic Committee it was determined that a timed parking zone appears to be an acceptable use for tenant and customer parking for the businesses and residential use in the area. Riki Heath made a motion that a 30 minute parking zone be painted on South 5th Street

from on the west curb line from Grand Avenue to the driveway of 480 West Grand Avenue. Greg Ray seconded the motion. All present were in favor. No one was opposed. Chief Copsey will prepare Staff Report for City Council consideration.
