## 🔊 NOTICE OF COMMITTEE VACANCIES 🔊 CITIZEN OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Grover Beach encourages residents to apply for positions on City Commissions and Committees that have vacancies. When vacancies occur, the City actively recruits applicants for the positions by publishing Notices of Vacancies in the local newspapers and posting the notice in the City's three (3) public posting locations.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that:

- **Two (2) vacancies** exist on the **Citizen Oversight Committee** due to the expiration of two Committee terms on January 15, 2010. Committee terms are for four-year periods; however, two of the initial citizen appointments to the newly formed Committee were for two-year terms.

The Citizen Oversight Committee is a body of five Grover Beach residents scheduled to meet no less than once annually regarding the one-half percent sales tax increase that was approved by a majority of the voters at the November 2006 General Municipal Election (Measure X-06). The Citizen Oversight Committee is to review an annual public report regarding expenditures from the one-half percent Transactions and Use Tax. The annual report will include information on budgeted expenditures for the upcoming fiscal year. The Citizen Oversight Committee will then provide a report on expenditures of the revenues generated from the Transaction and Use Tax to the City Council no less than six months following the close of the fiscal year. Committee meetings are open to the public and subject to the Brown Act.

Applications are available at the City Clerk's Office, Grover Beach City Hall, 154 South Eighth Street, Grover Beach.
