Street Rehabilitation & Repair Program

Paving Operations to Begin on the Largest Street Improvement Project in City History

Grover Beach, CA – Exciting News! The City of Grover Beach is pleased to announce that preliminary work for the current street repair project comprising 53 blocks, the largest single street improvement project undertaken in the City's history, is now complete on a number of streets. That work included upgrading corner ramps to meet ADA requirements and upgrading water, sewer, and gas utilities buried in the streets, as well as lowering existing utility access covers and sewer manholes.

The City will begin paving operations in late November with grinding to remove existing pavement. This work begins on South 8th Street from W. Grand Avenue to Farroll Road before shifting to other streets shown on the following map of streets being rehabilitated in this current phase. Upon completion of this project, the City will have expended 27% of the total \$48 million in bonds approved by voters in November 2014 with the passage of Measure K-14. Additional streets will be included in future projects.

Since passage of Measure K-14, the City issued the first two bonds in the series for a total of \$13 million. On November 6, 2017, the City Council took action for the next bond issue in the amount of \$15 million to fund further street repairs over the next 2-3 years.

Please note:

For Street Construction on South 8th Street and Access to Grover Beach City Hall

(South 8th Street between W. Grand Avenue & Farroll Road)

- **Street Access and Parking Will be Restricted**
Vehicles must be off the street *prior* to 7:00 am Monday thru Friday.
On-street parking will be prohibited during working hours in construction areas.
Residents and guests will need to park on adjacent side streets until after working hours.
- **All Side Streets Within One Block of South 8th Street**
Adjacent streets will be closed to through traffic during and after working hours.
- **Driveway Access, Trash Pick-up, Mail and Package Deliveries**
The Contractor has been instructed to maintain access to driveways and access for trash pick-up, and access for mail and package deliveries will be maintained.
- **Access to Grover Beach City Hall**
Due to traffic control measures described above, the best route to access City Hall will be from Rockaway Avenue, via South 7th Street (rather than from West Grand Avenue, via South 8th Street).

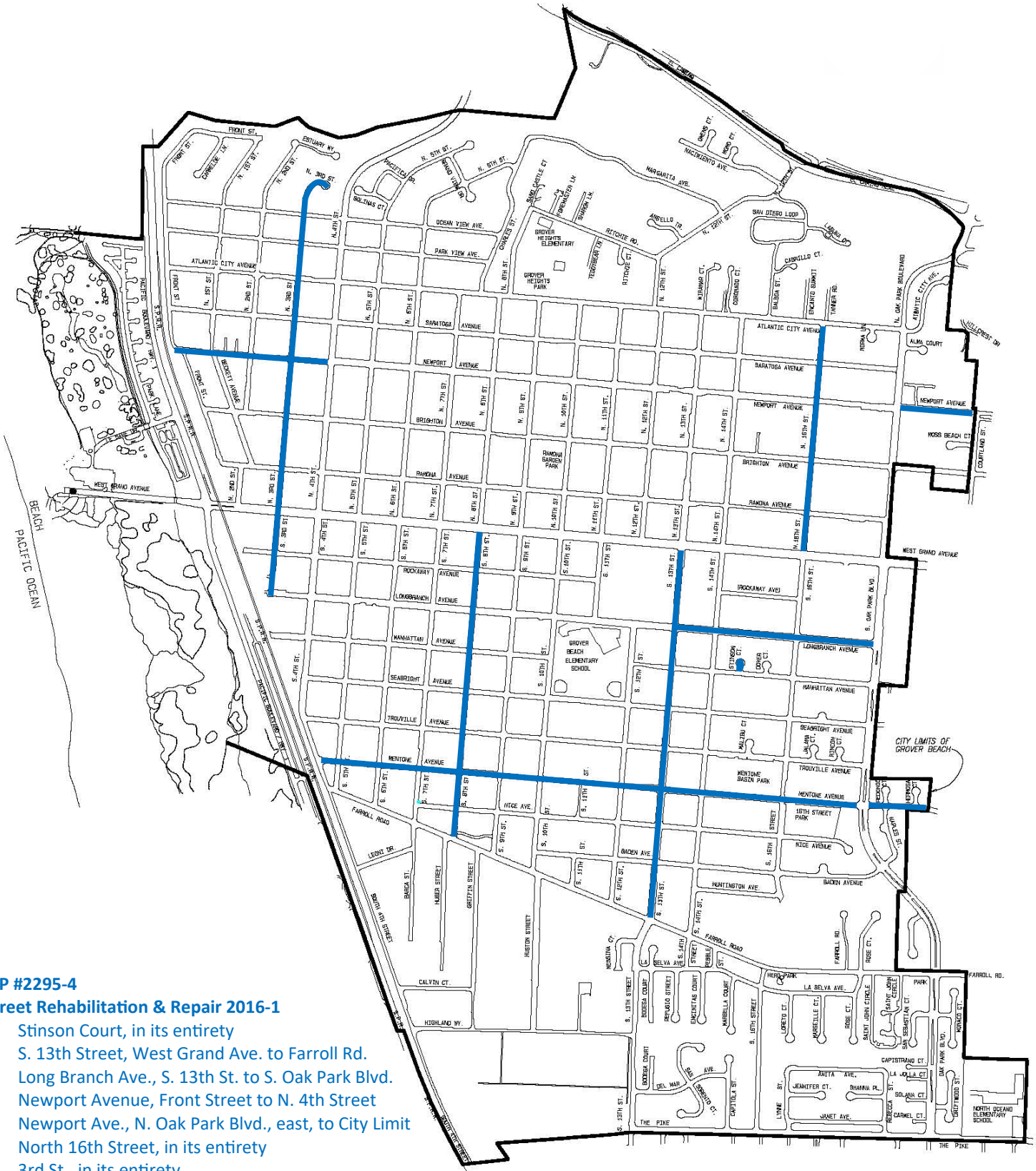
