### **HYDRANT TESTING SCHEDULED FOR WEDNESDAY**

GROVER BEACH, CA – As part of the City’s Water Master Plan Update, flow testing of several fire hydrants throughout the City will be conducted on **Wednesday, March 6, 2019**. The data collected during the test will inform the City about the condition of the City’s water system and capabilities in the event of an emergency.

The hydrant testing is scheduled to begin at 8:00 a.m. and is expected to take approximately 5 hours to complete. During the duration of the testing, affected properties may experience some discoloration or turbidity in your water. This condition is temporary and will usually clear within a few hours.

In order to clear the water, please allow the water to flow from an **outside faucet for a few minutes**. This water will cause NO damage to your plants or lawn so feel free to direct it into your flowerbeds or lawn.
