## **NOTICE OF COMMISSION VACANCY** **PARKS, RECREATION & BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Grover Beach encourages residents to apply to serve on City Commissions and Committees. The City recruits for applicants by publishing a Notice of Vacancy in the local newspapers and posting notices in the City’s three (3) public posting locations, as well as the City website and Government Cable Access Channel 20. Applications are accepted throughout the year.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the City of Grover Beach is currently seeking residents interested in serving on the **Grover Beach Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission**:

- **Three (3) seats** on the Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission are currently open due to 2 unscheduled vacancies and one term of office expiration. Terms on the Commission are four-year periods with the term ending in May 31, 2023, with no term limits.

The Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission is a body of five (5) residents that meets on a monthly basis. Regularly scheduled meetings are held on the 3rd Thursday of each month at 6:30 p.m., with special meetings as needed. The Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission serves as an advisory body to the City Council and the Parks and Recreation Department regarding parks, recreation, community events, and beautification efforts. The Commission is actively involved with the Parks and Recreation Department, providing advice on special events throughout the year. Interviews with interested applicants are typically held before a City Screening Committee, with recommendations forwarded to the City Council for consideration and appointment(s) at a regular City Council meeting. Applicants must be registered voters of the City of Grover Beach.
