## **City of Grover Beach Announces Pavement of North 4<sup>th</sup> Street in Grover Beach Scheduled**

### **\*\* Notice of Temporary Road Closure and Detour \*\***

Paving of North 4<sup>th</sup> Street is scheduled for the week of **January 12-16, 2009**. Work will be completed from Ocean View Avenue to the City's northern boundary line located adjacent to the City of Pismo Beach. The actual date and time of the paving is somewhat uncertain, due to the fact that the air temperature must be warm enough to permit the installation of the asphalt mix used in the repaving.

Once the paving work is initiated, it should be completed in a single day. **The paving will require the closure of North 4<sup>th</sup> Street (from Ocean View Avenue to the northern City limit line).** Motorists will be directed to use **Atlantic City Avenue to North 12<sup>th</sup> Street** during the temporary road closure.

The project is being completed as a part of the City's on-going Local Street Rehabilitation Program. The street was last repaved by the City approximately 10 years ago and was selected for repaving because North 4<sup>th</sup> Street is a major gateway entrance to the City of Grover Beach. Papich Construction was awarded the contract for the work.
