Grover Beach Beautification Day is Saturday, September 25th

GROVER BEACH, CA — The City of Grover Beach is sending out a call for all volunteers to participate in the next “Grover Beach Beautification Day” scheduled for Saturday morning, September 25, 2010. Mayor Shoals and the City Council set September 25th as the next work day in an effort to beautify and clean up Grover Beach.

Volunteers are encouraged to bring gloves and meet at the City Hall parking lot located at 154 South 8th Street at 8:00 a.m. Teams of volunteers will receive assignments to clean up public areas along the City’s major streets, including West Grand Avenue and 4th Street. All work is expected to be completed by noon on that day. According to Mayor Shoals, the intent of the cleanup effort is to demonstrate community pride and improve the community’s appearance for residents and visitors alike. The Grover Beach Rotary has also indicated the organization will field a team to assist in the effort. This event will coincide with Fall Clean-up Week, which is sponsored by South County Sanitary Service from September 20 - September 24, 2010.

Mayor Shoals initiated the first of the monthly clean up days last month, with assistance from Mayor Pro Tem Nicolls, Council Member Bright, members of Youth With A Mission (YWAM), and community members. Last month, the group completed tree plantings and installing groundcover in public planters located along Ramona Avenue and adjacent to the Exploration Station. Beautification Day will now be scheduled on a monthly basis. Each Beautification Day will occur on a pre-designated Saturday and will focus on several locations within the City.
