“Grover Beach Beautiful Day” is Saturday, December 18th

GROVER BEACH, CA — The Mayor and City of Grover Beach are sending out a call for all volunteers to participate in the next “Grover Beach Beautiful Day” scheduled for **Saturday morning, December 18, 2010**. Mayor Shoals and the City Council set the third Saturday of each month as work days to beautify and spruce up areas in Grover Beach.

Weather permitting, volunteers are encouraged to bring gloves and meet at the City Hall parking lot located at **154 South 8th Street at 8:00 a.m.** Teams of volunteers will receive assignments to clean up public areas along the City’s major streets. All work is expected to be completed by noon on that day. According to Mayor Shoals, the intent of the effort is to demonstrate community pride and improve the community’s appearance for residents and visitors alike.

The first beautification day was held in August and consisted of tree plantings and installation of groundcover in the public planters on Ramona Avenue and adjacent to the Exploration Station. The Fall beautification days focused on West Grand Avenue near 4th Street and 8th Street, as well as the City’s Demonstration Garden at Ramona Garden Park.

“Grover Beach Beautiful Day” is scheduled on a monthly basis. Each of these events will occur on a pre-designated Saturday and will focus on several locations within the City. In the event of rain, the event will be cancelled.
