“Grover Beach Beautiful Day” Scheduled for Saturday, September 17th has been Cancelled

GROVER BEACH, CA — The Mayor and City of Grover Beach are sending out a call for all volunteers to participate in the next “Grover Beach Beautiful Day” scheduled for **Saturday morning, September 17, 2011**. Mayor Shoals and the City Council set the third Saturday of each month as work days to beautify and spruce up areas in Grover Beach.

The first beautification day was held in August 2010 and consisted of tree plantings and installation of groundcover in the public planters on Ramona Avenue and adjacent to the Exploration Station. Subsequent beautification days focused on West Grand Avenue near 4th Street and 8th Street, as well as the City’s Demonstration Garden at Ramona Garden Park.

“Grover Beach Beautiful Day” is scheduled on a monthly basis, weather permitting. Each of these events held on a pre-designated Saturday will focus on several locations within the City. In the event of rain, the event will be cancelled.
