## **Three-Month Reduction in Street Sweeping and Park Maintenance**

**Grover Beach** -- Due to budget constraints, the City of Grover Beach will be reducing park maintenance and street sweeping between April 5<sup>th</sup> and July 1<sup>st</sup>. These services will be re-evaluated during budget hearings to determine the appropriate level of service in fiscal year 2013.

Street sweeping in Grover Beach will be reduced to once per week on West Grand Avenue, and once per month on the other major roads, which include: Oak Park Boulevard, 4<sup>th</sup> Street, 13<sup>th</sup> Street, Atlantic City Avenue, Longbranch Avenue, and Mentone Avenue, and eliminated completely on the remainder of the streets.

Turf maintenance and watering at City parks will be reduced to approximately half of the current level for the remainder of the fiscal year, with the exception of 16<sup>th</sup> Street and Ramona Garden Park, which will remain the same. This temporary cost-saving measure will assist the City in reducing financial obligations for the remainder of the budget year.
