OLD BUSINESS

- 1) Approval of Minutes from July 12, 2012.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1) South 13th Street and Manhattan Avenue and South 13th Street and Trouville Avenue

Citizen reports safety and visibility issues for the school zones at South 13th Street and Manhattan Avenue and South 13th Street and Trouville Avenue. Citizen reports that it is difficult for drivers to safely see the children before they cross the street due to vehicles parking too close to the corner along the west side of South 13th Street at Manhattan blocking the view of southbound traffic, and along the east side of the South 13th Street at Trouville Avenue in front of Willy's Market blocking the view of northbound traffic.

2) South 16th Street from Farroll Avenue to the Pike

Citizen reports traffic safety issues on South 16th Street due to the speed of vehicles going from Farroll Avenue to the Pike and is requesting the City to consider traffic calming measures to be implemented. He is requesting 4-way stop signs at South 16th Street and La Selva Avenue, or other methods to help slow traffic down.

3) 244 North Oak Park Boulevard

Citizen would like the City's assistance with a traffic issue on Oak Park Boulevard, specifically for vehicles exiting Peace Lutheran Church at 244 North Oak Park Boulevard.

Drivers exiting the parking lot from Peace Lutheran Church onto Oak Park Boulevard and heading south have been cited for "crossing the double yellow line". Ms. Carpentier is requesting the City consider installing a "turn pocket or turn lane" from vehicles heading south from the church parking lot. The church facility is used during the week for a pre-school program and several parents have received citations.
