**Grover Beach** – Grover Beach Parks, Recreation and Beautification Commission Chair, former Mayor, and current Lucia Mar Unified School District Board (LMUSD) Trustee **Dee Santos**, has been chosen as the Grand Marshal of the 47<sup>th</sup> Annual Holiday Parade to be held on Saturday, December 7, 2013 in Grover Beach. This year's theme is "Under the Sea".

Dee Santos, originally a native of Riverdale, California, has been a very active and integral member of the Grover Beach and South County community for over 45 years.

Serving on the Grover Beach City Council for three four-year terms of office (from 1986-1991, 1996-2000, and from 2000-2004, serving in the office of Mayor in 1998 and 2004).

In addition to her amazing public service commitments, Dee has also been a very successful business owner, operating Salon Dee for 46 years, and is currently providing hair services at A Better Hair Day. She has also worked over 36 years at Marshall Spoo.

"I felt happily surprised and was expecting to be the one to nominate someone. I'm usually the voice of people who won't speak for themselves" said Dee, after being notified by Parks and Recreation Program Director Kathy Petker. Once nominations were received, the Holiday Parade Planning Committee met and determined the final winner.

Dee is always willing to volunteer her time to make sure things get done. She will bake cookies for special events and meetings, purchase supplies, provide historical information regarding the community, open her home for special occasions, and do it all with a smile. Dee was instrumental in the major fundraising effort to ensure the South County Skate Park was built in Grover Beach in 1999. She also initiated the popular Plant Exchange as part of the annual Spring Garden Tour.
