City of Grover Beach Announces Office Closure for Holiday Period

GROVER BEACH, CA — In an effort to minimize City costs during the holiday period, all Grover Beach City Hall offices will be closed to the public for the one-week period from **Monday, December 22 through Friday, December 26, 2014**. All regular business hours and field operations will resume on Monday, December 29th. City Hall offices will also be closed on **Thursday, January 1, 2015** in observance of New Year's Day.

City Hall offices will be closed to the public for a total of three working days and two regularly scheduled holidays of December 24-25, 2014. Employees desiring the additional time off will be required to use authorized leave (i.e., vacation, accrued compensation or administrative leave time). The Council approved the closure in November when reviewing the City's end of the year calendar. *"The holiday scheduled closure of City Hall to the public will allow the remaining skeletal staff to continue to function and minimize costs. The closure also provides employees the opportunity to spend additional quality time with their families"* said City Manager Bob Perrault.

In the event of a safety emergency, citizens should continue to make use of the emergency contact number 9-1-1. In the event of a non-safety related event, citizens should contact the Grover Beach Police Department business line at (805) 473-4511 and the appropriate personnel will be dispatched by the department. Public Works crew members will be available to respond to any weather-related emergency, should it occur.

The first regularly scheduled City Council meeting in the New Year will be Tuesday, January 20, 2015 following the Martin Luther King holiday on Monday January 19th. The regular City Council schedule of meetings on the first and third Mondays of the month will resume in February.
