Grover Beach City Council Sets Workshops to Gather Community Input on Street Rehabilitation and Repair Program

GROVER BEACH, CA — The Grover Beach City Council is inviting residents and businesses to participate in a series of public workshops and meetings to gather input for the Street Rehabilitation and Repair Program. Thanks to the voters' authorization, the City will sell up to \$48 million in Bonds to fund the undertaking of a major project to repair and rebuild local streets. The City Council is seeking citizen input on criteria that could be used to select candidate streets. According to Mayor Shoals, *"The public workshops are a great opportunity for community members to learn about the street rehabilitation program and to give input on the prioritization factors that will be used to develop the strategy for street repairs in the city. We want to hear from the community."*

The first Council hosted workshop will be held on **Wednesday, February 11, 2015 at 6:00 p.m.** in the Grover Beach Community Center located at 1230 Trouville Avenue, Grover Beach. The second workshop will be held on **Monday, February 23, 2015 at 6:00 p.m.** in the Ramona Garden Park Center located at 993 Ramona Avenue, Grover Beach. In addition to the workshops, residents and businesses can give input on the Street Rehabilitation Program at the regular City Council meeting on **Tuesday, February 17th** at Grover Beach City Hall, 154 South 8th Street. The workshop sessions are designed to be interactive and the attendees will be asked to weigh in on prioritizing several factors, including repairing more frequently used streets, repair of streets important for public safety and repairing streets in the vicinity of local schools, as well as organizing street repair by area or land use (i.e., commercial, industrial or residential).
