West Grand Avenue Enhancement Project, Phase 2

8th Street—11th Street

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project consist of landscaped center medians, landscape irrigation and lighting, accessible corner ramps, sidewalk and street repairs, slurry sealing and striping. The goals of the project are to enhance and clearly define the City's downtown core, slow traffic and encourage pedestrian use.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

This project is expected to start in early January and require a little over three months to complete. Weather permitting the project is expected to be complete by mid-May.

TRAFFIC DELAYS AND ALTERNATE PARKING

Motorists should expect lane closures and intermittent traffic delays.

Alternate parking is available on all side streets, in the public parking lot behind the Post Office, at the Rabobank parking lot, and the parking lot adjacent to City Hall on 8th Street.

PROJECT COST & FUNDING

Total project costs are estimated at **\$1.2 million dollars** with funding coming from a variety of sources including \$832,000 in Federal Grant funds, obtained with the assistance of the San Luis Obispo Council of Governments (SLOCOG) and \$292,000 in Gas Tax Funds. The remainder of the funding is from other City sources.

CONTRACTOR

The work will be performed by **Brough Construction.**
