PUBLIC NOTICE REGARDING ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

(Please Do Not Discard)

In conjunction with the North Oak Park Rehabilitation project, the City of Grover Beach will be removing old pavement and repaving the intersection of West Grand Avenue at North Oak Park Boulevard. Paving of the intersection will improve the ride and movement of vehicles in this location.

LOCATION: The work is located within the crosswalk limits of the intersection and extends to the eastern city limit on West Grand Avenue and north on North Oak Park Boulevard to Ramona Avenue.

SCHEDULE: **Night Work** will occur, beginning at **10:00 p.m.** and continue until **5:00 a.m.** **During the night work, the intersection will be shut down,** and detours will be established to route traffic around it. Most, but not all, businesses are closed between these hours. Through traffic will be allowed to access open businesses.

NIGHT WORK (10:00 p.m. – 5:00 a.m.)

Sunday, August 14th: Remove (grind-out) Old Pavement

Monday, August 15th: Localized Paving (problem areas)

Thursday, August 18th: Pave West Grand Avenue & North Oak Park Boulevard

Monday, August 22nd: Raise Utility Manholes

Tuesday, August 23rd: Final Striping

DAY WORK (7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.)

Monday, August 15th – Thursday, August 18th: Traffic Loops

Be aware that asphalt will be used in this project and businesses should not park any vehicles adjacent to Grand Avenue overnight to avoid any overspray of oil during the paving process.
