# Your Measure K-14 TAX DOLLAR\$ AT WORK!

Weekly Construction Update: October 2, 2017

The City is continuing the multi-year project to rehabilitate streets utilizing voter approved bond funds generated by Measure K-14. To date the City has expended approximately \$6 million of the total \$48 million project budget on previous contracts for street repair. The current contract will expend approximately \$7 million. 1. This week the City's contractor encountered unforeseen issues during the installation of a new 10" water main in **North 16<sup>th</sup> Street between Brighton and Newport Avenues**. Once rescheduled, notifications will be distributed to affected properties regarding a temporary water service disruption in order to complete the work. The new water main is expected to be complete by mid-October.
2. Over the next two weeks, the City's contractor will be installing fire hydrants at **South 13th Street and Baden Avenue, South 13th Street and Seabright Avenue, and South 16th Street and Mentone Avenue**. Sidewalk closures and minor traffic delays are anticipated in these locations while the work is being performed.
3. Construction of new curb ramps and portions of new sidewalk on **South 8th Street**, between West Grand Avenue and Farroll Road are expected to be complete by the end of October.
4. Last week the demolition of several curb ramps located on **Mentone Avenue between South 5th Street and the eastern City Limit** began. Construction of new curb ramps are expected to be complete by the end of October.
5. A broadband communication company is installing cables below and above ground at various locations throughout the City. This work is under the direction of your Public Works Department, but is not part of the Measure K-14 street repair work.
6. Rehabilitation and repair of **South 4th Street between Seabright Avenue and Farroll Road** is nearing completion. New signage is expected to be installed soon. This project is expected to be complete by the end of October. This work is under the direction of your Public Works Department, but is not part of the Measure K-14 street repair work.
7. Asphalt pavement work is expected to begin this fall. Specific locations and durations will be identified as we get closer to that time.

This status update is intended to inform the public on the status of the Measure K-14 Street Rehabilitation and Repair Project. Field conditions and work progress are monitored daily and are subject to change daily. As a result, the dates indicated in this update are also subject to change. Schedule and location information is most accurate within three weeks of the date of this posting. Information will be updated weekly.
