Weekly Construction Update: March 9, 2018

The City is continuing the multi-year project to rehabilitate streets utilizing voter approved bond funds generated by Measure K. To date the City has expended approximately \$6 million of the total \$48 million project budget on previous contracts for street repair. The current contract will expend approximately \$7 million. 1. The City has completed all of the water system upgrades included in this project.
2. Construction of new accessible curb ramps and cross gutters on **South 13th Street**, between West Grand Avenue and Farroll Road, will continue for several weeks. Expect minor traffic delays while the work is being performed.
3. Demolition and construction of new accessible curb ramps and cross gutters on **Long Branch Avenue**, between Oak Park Boulevard and South 13th Street, and on **North 16th Street**, between West Grand Avenue and Atlantic City Avenue, and on **Stinson Court** will continue for several weeks. Expect minor traffic delays while the work is being performed.
4. Paving of **Long Branch Avenue**, between Oak Park Boulevard and South 13th Street, will begin next week. Work will include removal of the existing road and installation of new base material followed by the application of new asphalt. The road will be closed to thru traffic during the paving operation.
5. Paving of **North 3rd Street**, between West Grand Avenue and Long Branch Avenue, is nearing completion. The remaining work, including the adjustment of underground utility lids, modifications to private driveways and the installation of asphalt dikes will continue over the next two weeks. Expect minor traffic delays while the work is being performed.
6. This status update is intended to inform the public on the status of the Measure K-14 Street Rehabilitation and Repair Project. Field conditions and work progress are monitored daily and are subject to change daily. As a result, the dates indicated in this update are also subject to change. Schedule and location information is most accurate within three weeks of the date of this posting. Information will be updated weekly.
