1) 1150 Farroll Road

This item was discussed by the Traffic Committee. After discussion it was agreed that Greg Ray would get in touch with the business at this address and see if the bush there can be removed. Traffic Committee felt that removal of the bush will give Public Works employees the sight necessary to be able to have a clear sight to enter onto Farroll Road. This matter can come back to the Traffic Committee if the business does not want to remove the bush or if when the bush is removed there is still a concern about pulling onto Farroll Road. All present agreed with this.

2) 922 Front Street

Public Works is requesting a red curb at this address in front of the City's lift station to allow room for the work trucks and trailer mounted generator.

This is in case of a power outage or other emergency situation that would make it necessary to set up the emergency generator. Mike Wilson made a motion to paint the curb red at 922 Front Street and Bruce Buckingham seconded the motion. All present were in favor.
