OLD BUSINESS

Approval of Minutes – Chief Peters asked if all present had read the minutes for March 8, 2018, meeting. Bruce Buckingham made a motion that the minutes be approved. Chief Peters seconded the motion. All others present were in favor of approval of the Minutes.

NEW BUSINESS

1) **4th Street and West Grand Avenue**

Citizen is asking that the City consider painting four or five spaces red at the corner of 4th Street and West Grand Avenue in front of Mongos. Citizen feels that this is dangerous and could pose a traffic collision problem when vehicles are parked in the first legal space adjacent to this intersection.

This item was discussed by the Traffic Committee. The roadway striping is consistent with across the street as the street lane is also a right hand turn lane. Large trucks and trailers need to have this space to make their turns onto Grand Avenue. If this area was painted there would be greater chances of accidents as larger vehicles would not be able to negotiate their right hand turns. The no parking element issue was brought up. After discussion there was a motion by Bruce Buckingham that the request be denied. Stephen Lieberman seconded the motion. All present were in favor.
