Establish Commissioner assigned zone areas throughout the City for review of residential and business improvements and decorations for public recognition.

### **BACKGROUND**

Staff has prepared a map of the city that is divided in to five areas and each member of the PRBC has been assigned to a specific zone of the City to recognize the publics' efforts of improvements and beautifications. In general, improvements to recommend for recognition could include new landscaping, plants, paint, etc. Furthermore, in general, the PRBC members are assigned to areas that are closest to their neighborhood.
