NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Grover Beach encourages residents to apply to serve on a City board, commission or committee. In compliance with the requirements of the Maddy Act of 1975, Government Code Sections 54970-72 et seq, the City annually posts a list by December 31st of all appointive terms which will expire during the next calendar year, as well as a list of all boards, commissions, and committees whose members serve at the pleasure of the City Council, and the necessary qualifications for each position.

The appointment process typically includes an interview before a Screening Committee, followed by approval and official appointment by the City Council at a noticed public meeting.
